ATTENDEES ELIGIBILITY

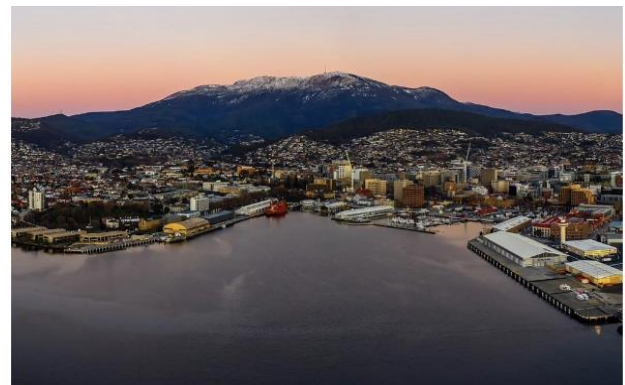
All Applicants must have a current AGU handicap and must be a financial member of their respective state organisations and meet the eligibility criteria as defined by the current ACGA Rules.

CAPITATION FEE

The Capitation fee has been set by the Committee at **\$1,600.00 (inc GST)** per member -

This fee is payable with your application or **paid before November 30th, 2023** for you application to be approved.

Capitation Fees exclude accommodation, drinks (except those provided at dinners as described above) and private dinners.





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ACCOMMODATION DETAILS – BARNBOUGLE & LOST FARM

Saturday, Sunday & Monday accommodation will be at either Barnbougle Dunes or Lost Farm in an assortment of options. Bookings will be secured by date of entry as some options are limited. Please include your roommates' names when applying.

Breakfast is included in room tariffs and is served in the Main Restaurant at both Barnbougle Dunes and Lost Farm from 6.00am.

Internet access and onsite parking are available free of charge.

Credit card details are required to hold rooms, however late cancellation (after 1st February) may incur up to 3 nights room charges. **TCGC Committee recommends that attendees take out personal travel insurance to cover this possibility.**

ACCOMMODATION DETAILS– HOBART

On Tuesday, we travel to Hobart for the remaining 4 nights at the Hotel Grand Chancellor on the Hobart Waterfront.

The room options are either Harbour or City views, with single and twin/double rooms.

Options, and bookings will be secured by date of entry as some options are limited.

Please include your roommates' name when applying – note, there are no triple or quad rooms available.

Breakfast is available from 6am but is not included in room tariffs. Parking is available at \$15 daily. Credit card details are required to hold rooms, late cancellation (after 1st February) may incur up to 4 nights room charges. **TCGC Committee recommends that attendees take out personal travel insurance to cover this possibility.**

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AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Saturday March 2nd

For those arriving from interstate two buses will be provided from Launceston Airport to Barnbougle/Lost Farm on Saturday March 2nd.

1st bus is scheduled to depart at 1pm with 45 seats available.

2nd bus is scheduled to depart at 4pm with 45 seats available.

Both buses will have space for luggage and golf clubs.

Please nominate when registering if you intend to use either the 1pm or 4pm bus.

Spaces will be allocated in order of date of registration.

if you are using this service, please ensure that you book your flights to Launceston to allow ample time to collect your luggage and golf clubs.

Saturday March 9th

Options include Airport Shuttles, Taxis, Uber etc.

FORMAT FOR EACH GOLFING DAY

Each day there will be split shotgun starts, an **8am morning** round and a **1pm afternoon** round.

All participants will be given the option to nominate which they prefer. **HOWEVER**, while every endeavor will be made to meet these preferences, allocation will be at the discretion of the host state and **NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS WILL BE MADE.**

Morning Players will travel back to their accommodation venues after lunch at the golf club.

Morning players will then travel back to the dinner venues arriving around 6.15pm each night.

Afternoon players will have lunch provided at the golf course prior to their round.

All drinks will be provided for the Opening Dinner. For the following four dinners there will be a bar tab for pre-dinner drinks each night and three bottles of wine will be provided per table of 8.

MOTORISED CARTS

Motorised carts are restricted at all golf courses and are only available for players with current medical certificates. There will be no charge for motorized carts.

Barnbougle and Lost Farm

2-Seater Carts (1 player)	10	Players	10

So, this means a maximum of 16 AM and 16 PM players – every cart **MUST** have a certified driver from Barnbougle/Lost Farm.

Royal Hobart Golf Club

Royal have 12x2 seater club carts, so 24 AM and 24 PM players.

Tasmania Golf Club

Tasmania have 18x2 seater carts - they cannot guarantee the battery lasting 36 holes – the solution appears to be 18 carts AM = 36 players and 9 carts PM = 18 players with a change of carts after 3,4,5,6,7,8,9 holes to a fully charged cart = total of 54 players for the day.

Kingston Beach Golf Club

8 carts AM and PM = 32 players for the day.

The application form allows you to indicate whether you need a cart. If you require a cart, you may forfeit your preference for an AM or PM start, depending on availability of carts in the AM or PM.

Please CLEARLY indicate your requirements on entry application.



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DRESS

For all functions, all that is required is neat casual attire as defined by most private clubs (i.e. NO denim jeans and/or joggers allowed). Anyone who wishes, should feel free to wear a “jacket & tie” to any of the dinners especially our traditional opening and closing dinners.

Accessing the ACGA WEB Site

- Login to www.acga.net.au
- Click Login
- Enter your email address as the username – this should be the email address your state chemist golf club uses to communicate with you.
- Enter your password. If you have never changed this password, it will be the last 4 digits of your Golf Link number.
- Once you are successfully logged in, you will see under the Menu Group “Members”, the item “Carnival Application”.
- If this is the first time you are entering an application, you will see “75th ACGA Carnival Tasmania – Register”. Click Register to access the application form.
- If you are returning to update your application, you will see “75th ACGA Carnival Tasmania – Update”. Click Update to update the application form.

If you cannot Login:

- Either your Username or Password is incorrect.
- Click “Forgot Your Password”
- You will be asked to enter your Email Address or Golf Link number.
- If you see the message “Email/GOLF Link number not found.” Then you are NOT registered in the ACGA database. Please contact your state secretary to get registered.
- You will receive and email with a temporary password.
- Use the temporary password to login and immediately change your password then click the Carnival Application menu item.
