# CARNIVAL DETAILS

## Carnival Portal

All players are registered on the ACGA website which will provide access to Carnival information through their phone, laptop, and computer. Details are also available on the NSW Chemists Golf Club website. Both will contain all the information you require including attendees, bus schedules, draws, course details & layouts, shots owed, results, and sponsors at a glance.

## Name badges

Name badges will be issued at registration. Please always wear your name badge. The name badges are retained by a magnet which may cause an issue if you have an electronic medical device. We can replace the tag with a pin type if you have a pacemaker. Thank you to **Paul Gough** from **Stirling Fildes** for providing the magazines, name and bag tags.

## Golf Clubs

Your golf clubs will be transported to and from each golf club via truck for the week, courtesy of **Allyn Beard** from **A.H. Beard**.

An identifying bag tag will be supplied at registration and will be attached to a visible location on your golf bag prior and placed in the designated holding bay at the Manly Pacific Hotel.

For those with carts, your golf bag will be placed on the carts by the golf club staff.

**Do not leave any glasses, wallets, keys, mobile phones, or any valuables in your bag as ACGA and any of its associates will not be held responsible for any loss or damage to these items.**

You will bring your Golf Bag back on the bus to the Manly Pacific Hotel after completion of golf on Friday.

**Players joining Simon at Avondale Golf Club** should not place their golf bags on the main golf bag truck at NSW Golf Club on Tuesday after play. A separate ute next to the truck, operated by **Tony Whittle**, will transport bags to Avondale for those wishing to use their own clubs. If you are driving yourself, you may take your clubs with you.



# MEALS

## Opening Dinner

The opening dinner is being held at the world famous **Sydney Opera House**, in the **Yallamundi Room**, with spectacular views and exclusive outdoor area. The access to the Yallamundi Room is via the Northern Broadwalk, so it's simple to get to from either side of the Opera House. Guests can walk around the outside of the House.

**Pre-dinner drinks from 6pm** prior to **dinner from 7pm**. The evening is sponsored by **Arrotex**, part of **DBG**.

**Dress for the opening dinner is Cocktail**. For men - Trousers, long sleeved shirt. **Jacket is compulsory**. For women - Cocktail Attire.

## Breakfast

Breakfast is at your own expense. It is not included in your room fee. Besides the hotel, there are many cafés and restaurants nearby with plenty of choices to suit.

# TRANSPORT

## Transport

Buses will transport all players to and from the course each day. The times for departure and return are detailed in the Carnival Schedule, and they will be strictly adhered to. If you miss the bus, it will be your responsibility to get to the course at your own expense. We request no food or drinks (other than water) be consumed on the buses.

Players are of course free to use your own transport to and from the golf clubs.

## Mobile Phones

The purpose of the Carnival is to enjoy the fellowship of all industry participants while playing golf. Use of mobile phones is a distraction from those objectives, so, we ask that use be limited to important issues only. Please ensure your volume is muted. The MiScore app operates on your phone to score the round. We request as a general courtesy that phones are not used during functions or announcements during the week. All golf clubs **do not** allow use of mobile phones for calls in the club house. For Monday at **Elanora Golf Club**, no mobile phone use on course or in the club house. You may use your Mobile in the designated area in the car park. Please respect the policy of each club.

**Please ensure your mobile is fully charged prior to commencing your round.**

# COMPETITION DETAILS

## Daily Event

The event each day will be a Single Stableford (SS) in conjunction with a 2 Ball Better Ball (2BBB) Stableford. The 2BBB will rank ahead of the SS for the purposes of prizes for the day. A player may only win one prize per day (excluding Challenge prizes). Speeches by the winners will be encouraged at the discretion of the Captain. Results will be posted on the ACGA website each day.

## Handicaps

The daily handicap will be adjusted in accordance with the course slope rating, scratch rating, par and the tees chosen by the player. Scores will be updated with Golfink daily.

## Shots Owed

The traditional shots owed system will operate for the week. Carried over shots from a previous carnival, will apply. Details of shots owed will be available on opening day. A 4-shot penalty will apply to daily winners and a 2-shot penalty to runners up. Existing 'shots owed' will reduce by 1 for every game played. Shots owed will be applied to the result for the day, not in the daily handicap. The ACGA website will be updated each day for shots owed. Ball bets will be calculated on the pre-shots owed scores.

# GAME ON!

## Ball Bets

Betting cards will be issued at the opening dinner. The usual operation will apply and we encourage participation to enhance the networking experience. Please ensure you place your name on the card so it can be returned if lost. We acknowledge **Colin Trebilcock** for developing the concept and donating the betting cards

## Course Rules

Each club is spike free on the course and in the clubhouse. Sand buckets are to be used and smoking is prohibited on the course and in the clubhouse. The Committee may issue Carnival playing rules that will apply to all games. These rules will be issued at registration and will be posted near the daily registration desk and on the Carnival Portal. Players are requested to check the notice and portal daily for any changes.

## Dress Requirements

All venues are private facilities and we request all players maintain a high standard of dress to comply with their rules and represent our organisation accordingly.

For all golf, appropriate golf attire as defined by most private clubs (i.e. collared shirts, tailored shorts with belt and either club or white socks only and, must be showing at ankle height. No denim and/or joggers allowed).

For all functions except opening night, neat casual attire with a minimum of trousers (no denim) and collared shirt with closed shoes is required for men. Jackets are optional. **Jackets are compulsory for the Opening Dinner.** Players may be requested to change if their dress does not meet these standards. Ladies to dress accordingly.

## Championships

The ACGA Championships will be played on Tuesday at NSW Golf Club – in each grade and veterans (70+). Each grade champion will be determined by the best Scratch Stableford score. The Veterans Championship will be decided by the best Stableford score. Any ties will be broken by a play-off over 18 holes at Manly Golf Club on Thursday. Play-offs will be played on the handicap applicable on Tuesday. We will attempt to ensure players in the play-off do so in the same field.

## Challenge Holes

**Natalie Siriani** and **Ken Green** from **Attain** are once again sponsoring the nearest the pin each day. Although players may win multiple NTP and/or drive prizes in a single day, they are not eligible to receive an NTP or drive prize on any subsequent day.

# RULES OF PLAY

## Grades

Grades are determined by your **G.A.** at the start of the Carnival and remain static for the duration of the Carnival. To determine the Grade, all G.A. Handicaps are converted to the nearest integer value, e.g., 11.5 is rounded up to 12 while 11.4 is rounded down to 11.

**A Grade = 0 to 14**      **B Grade = 15 to 20**      **C Grade = 21 & above**

Veterans are classified as 70 years and over as of 21 March 2026

## Score Cards

We will be using MiScore for all scoring, with a single backup card issued to each player. All team events will be calculated automatically once all scores have been submitted.

## Care of course

Soft spikes only are to be worn on the courses. Sand buckets must be carried and divots filled. Please observe the Local Rules as posted on the notice board near the pro shop.

## Electronic Devices

Range and distance finding devices are permitted for use during all competitions at the Carnival.

## Golf Carts

All courses have limited carts available approx. 20, with the exception of our Opening Day at Bayview with 45 carts. Priority will be given to players with medical conditions supported by a medical certificate if demand exceeds supply. Carts are not included in the Full Carnival Capitation Fee and must be paid for separately. Carts are included in the Legacy Carnival Program.

For those that qualify for a golf cart: Please care for the cart as if it were your own and keep out of the rough and away from bunkers and greens. Do not park carts in the front of greens but rather on the exit from the green towards the next tee. Any damage caused, as determined by the club, will be at the player's expense.

## Speed of Play

Speed of play is the scourge of all golfers. Marshals will be monitoring the course and will request groups to catch up if they fall behind the group in front. Under a local rule, after a warning, a Marshal has the authority to direct a group to pass through a hole, and the group will not score for that hole. To assist pace of play, the first two players to hole out should proceed to the next tee and be ready to play, with scores recorded after tee shots have been played.

## Tees

Players may choose to play from a forward tee and are encouraged to do so where the carry to the fairway is beyond their ability. Players should inform the Captain at registration or prior to the respective day if they wish to play from a forward tee. Their handicap will be adjusted accordingly, and they will be eligible for all daily prizes. However, Honour Board events and Fripp and Founders Cups must be played from the nominated tee.
